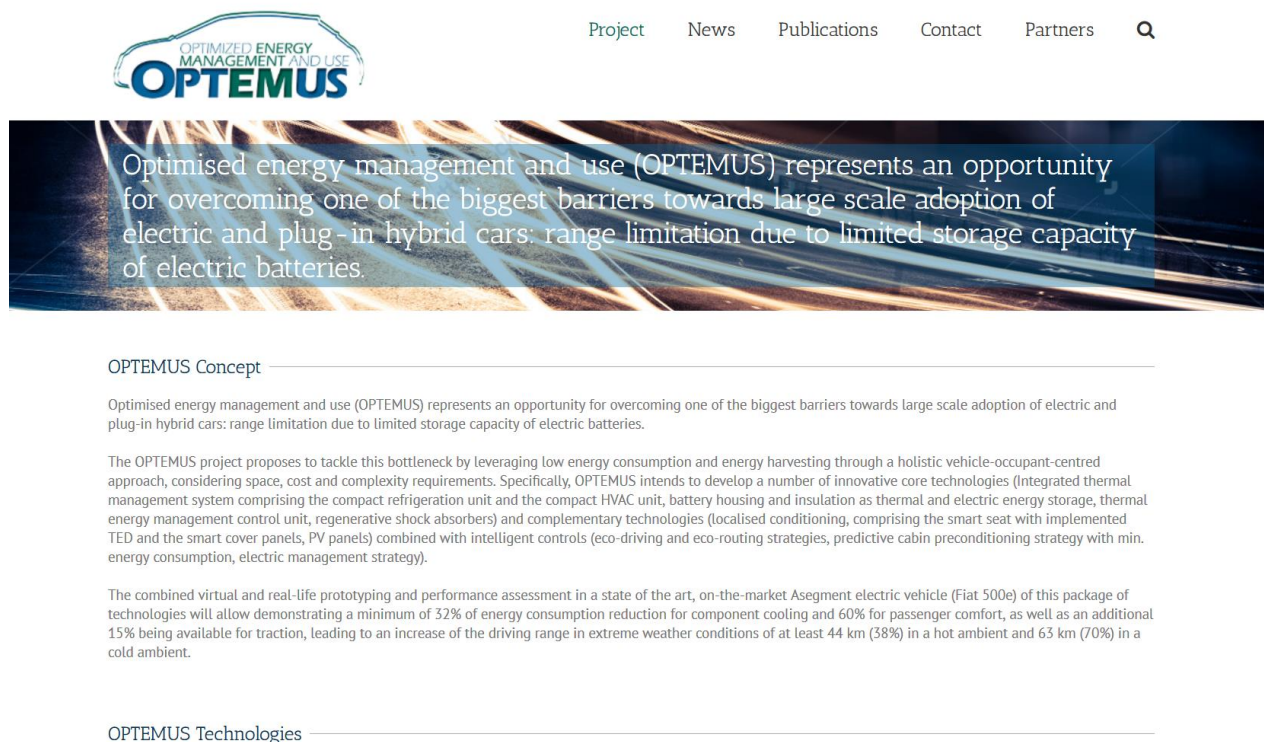


Figure 1: Page “Project” (Title page)

The page “Project” (Figure 1) shortly described the project concept and the used technologies. Further the latest news appear at the bottom.

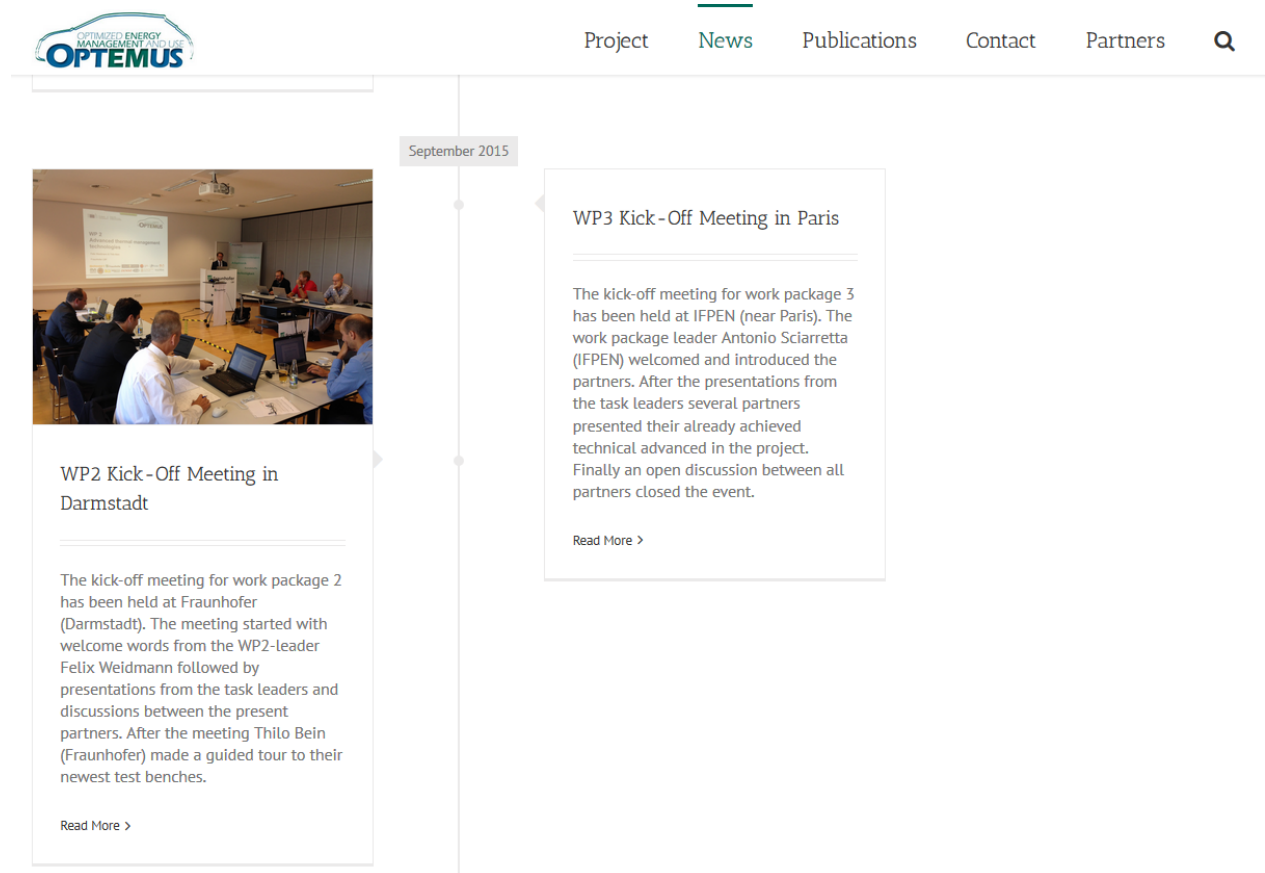



Figure 2: Page “News”

The page “News” (Figure 2) contains all important project events (e.g. meetings, dissemination events etc.) and depicts them on a timeline.

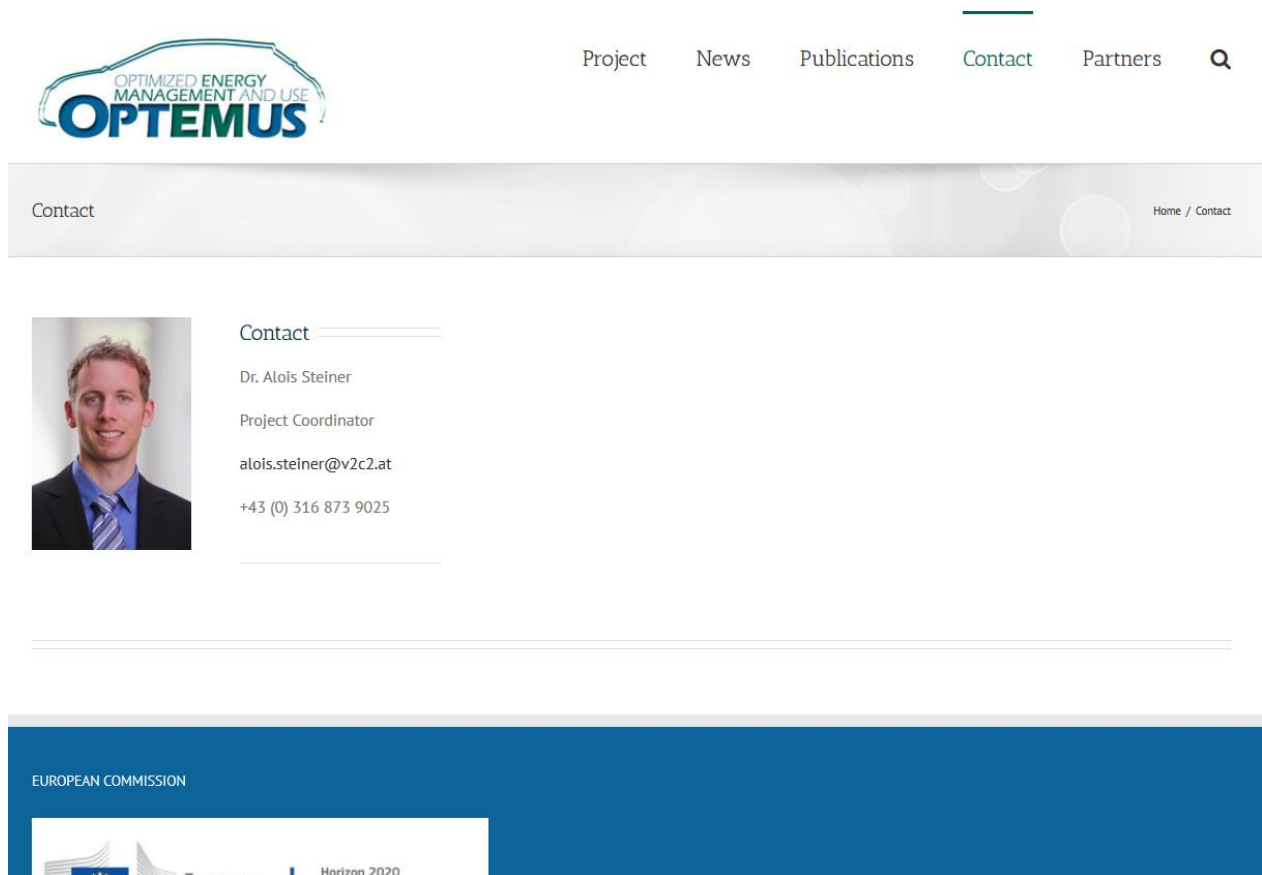


Figure 4: Page “Contact”

The page “Contact” (Figure 4) contains the contact details of the coordinator.

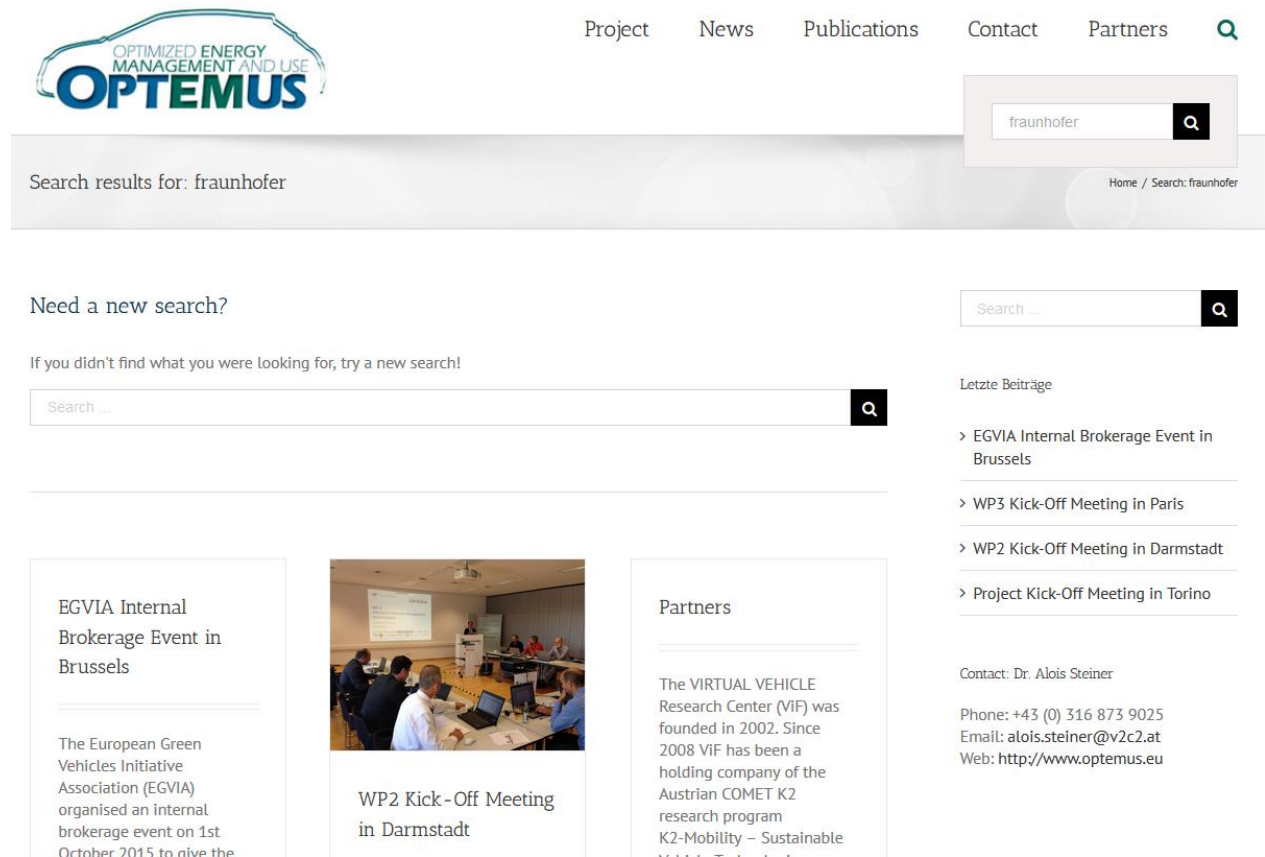


Figure 6: Search function of the website

Further the website has an integrated search function. Figure 6 shows the search results for the word “Fraunhofer”.
